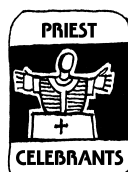

Isaiah 22:19-23 Psalm 138
Romans 11:33-36 Matthew 16:13-20

BE A ROCK

Peter's history as a follower or friend of Jesus is a bit spotty. It might be natural to wonder if Jesus, in giving him the keys to the kingdom, didn't feel a bit like a parent giving a teenager the keys to the family car. But it was at the moment when God's power and presence broke through everything else to raise up Peter's great profession of faith in Christ as Messiah that Jesus chose to establish the bond between the loving, forgiving mercy of heaven and our vocation to be witnesses of that love, mercy, and forgiveness on earth.

Like any parent, Jesus no doubt foresaw the failings, the irresponsible maneuvers or impaired senses, the collisions that the church would be headed for. But, most importantly, he also saw us at that moment as God prefers to see us: capable of manifesting great faith, with a willingness to remain at the feet of Christ to understand what it truly means to be Messiah and Christ. As the letter to the Romans points out to us today, we have not known the mind or the wisdom of God, but God knows us and still chooses to manifest the reign of justice, joy, beauty, and peace through us. Let this be our vocation. Let us always strive to be solid ground on which the church of Jesus Christ can be founded and on which it can continue to be built.

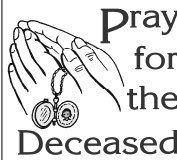

- Be at least 35 years of age by ordination but not older than 61 at the time of application (Exceptions can be made)
- Practicing Roman Catholic for five consecutive years or more
- Have lived within the Diocese of Reno for five consecutive years or more
- Have demonstrated leadership ability within parish and/or community organizations
- Be in good physical and mental health
- Have sufficient financial and employment stability
- For married men, have been married at least five years and have the positive consent of his wife and acceptance of his children
- Be sensitive to the time and needs of a well-adjusted family life
- Have sufficient time for formation and ministry
- Possess the desire and capacity for growth and continued education and for developing skills for ministry
- Possess an eagerness for prayer and acceptance of spiritual formation
- Be faithful to the traditions and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church
- Be open to the awareness of contemporary expressions in theology
- Be willing to make a commitment of talent and time
- Possess reading and writing skills (English) in order to participate fully in the academic program
- Have fingerprint clearance
- Participate in the “Protecting God’s Children” program
- Have some working knowledge of Spanish/be willing to learn Spanish
